EMERGENCIES

- If you are experiencing a medical emergency, please dial 911.
- If you are experiencing an eye emergency, please call our office at 262-547-3352. We are available 24/7 for emergent eye care.

APPOINTMENTS

- We see patients by appointment only. We do not currently take walk-ins.
- We continue to ask that patients do not arrive greater than 5 minutes prior to their appt time.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT AT YOUR APPOINTMENT

- Patients and visitors will be requested to answer screening questions related to the virus. Patients may be asked to reschedule their appointment in the event they may not meet screening recommendations.
- Except for those with respiratory symptoms, or may have shingles or pink eye, masking is optional for patients, visitors, and Medical Eye Associates employees.
- We ask that patients avoid close contact with others while waiting in line at the front desk as well as in the waiting room. Please maintain a 6-foot distance from others.
- We welcome a spouse or loved one if their presence will help in the care of the patient.
- Our physicians and staff will be adhering to standard precautions and guidelines provided for health care providers including wearing gloves and surgical masks. Eye protection may be used.
- Exam rooms will be limited in use and sterilized above and beyond our standard practices.

EYE INJECTIONS

- If you are receiving intravitreal therapy or eye injections for an eye condition such as macular degeneration or diabetes, we do consider your visit necessary and encourage you to keep your appointment. Failure to receive treatment may result in vision loss.
